

Ponte Vedra Inn & Club

Ponte Vedra Beach in Florida is perhaps one of the most overlooked luxury vacation spots in the United States. Just 20 miles southeast of Jacksonville, the oceanfront Ponte Vedra Inn & Club is nestled into a quaint seaside village surrounded by palm trees and magnificent dunes. The club originally opened in 1928, but has since been renovated to accommodate modern amenities without losing its historic charm.

Ponte Vedra Attractions

Whetstone Chocolate Factory: Tour includes an educational and entertaining video followed by a walk through the factory while chocolate masterpieces are being created.

World Golf Hall of Fame: A place to celebrate the global game of golf. This museum combines both traditional and interactive exhibits while paying tribute to the game's greatest players and contributors.

St. Augustine Alligator Farm: Featuring all 23 species of the world's crocodilians. Wildlife, bird shows and a petting zoo are favorite attractions at this local "hot spot."

Museum of Science and History: Visitors to this state-of-the-art museum are greeted by a giant dinosaur skeleton suspended from the ceiling. Exciting and educational exhibits are featured throughout the year. A planetarium on the third floor offers stellar light shows.

Adventure Landing: This 10-acre amusement park in Jacksonville Beach features water slides, wave pool, laser tag, go carts, miniature golf, batting cages and a full video arcade.

Anheuser-Busch Brewery: Hourly guided and self-guided tours show how beer is brewed and bottled.

Ghost Tours of St. Augustine: Saunter through the historic district by candlelight with professional guides in period attire. Meander the narrow brick-lined streets while peering into the existence of apparitions past and present.

Jacksonville Zoological Gardens: Visitors have access to the 20-acre nature reserve, home to Cape Buffalos, white rhinos, crocodiles, antelope and cheetahs.

San Sebastian Winery: Free tour of the winery explaining the complete winemaking process from the Florida Muscadine grape to the finished product.
