16 A. No, I have not.

17 Q. And why?

18 A. I think that's pretty self-explanatory.

19 Q. I'd like to hear your answer.

21 Q. And why don't you want to do it?

22 A. Because they put me through pretty much hell
23 the last few years.

24 Q. And can you describe what you mean by hell?

1 Q. Any other specifics besides the litigation?

22 clarification. Can I have just a minute to talk with
23 my client?

24 CROSS EXAMINATION

25 BY MR. FELOS:

1 Joan that her cousin had to remove her husband from the
 2 ventilator. This conversation came up with her and Terri
 3 and Terri told Joan according to Joan that she did the
 4 right thing and that Terri herself would not want to be
 5 like kept alive on the ventilator.

6 And according to Joan there was other
 7 conversations of again the t.v. They would be watching
 8 t.v. Conversation would come up and they would see
 9 something on t.v. that was devastating and Terri expressed
 10 her wishes then like she did to me that she would not want
 11 to be kept alive on any type of artificial means and she

 16 response to that question?
